Dear Parent/Guardian of Tar Hollow Camper:

Remember that we can have abundant mud due to days of rain before our arrival at Tar Hollow. You and your child/ren can help us make the experiences during our weekend more fun and joy than hassle and injury by coming prepared and flexible.

With growing numbers and changing attendees, we are continuing to maintain a few new rules to help with the smooth running of the Camporee and ensure that everyone has a good time. Please go over these with your family members before you arrive:

1. Registration forms will be included in the April UUFYS newsletter. They are also available online at www.uufys.org.
2. Young people under the age of 18 can attend only in the company of a parent or sponsor, or as the single guest of a child of an attending parent or sponsor. In other words, a child cannot invite more than one guest.
3. Parents or sponsors of all young people will have to fill out and sign a release of all claims and waiver of liability and a contract of behavior.
4. Cabin assignment will be made on a first come, first serve basis in consultation with the reception host/ess.
The host/ess will assist parents in being assigned to a cabin next to or the same as that of their children.
5. Each group of seven cabins will have a Hill Boss responsible for the Sunday clean-up and check out. NO camper may leave Tar Hollow on Sunday without being cleared by their Hill Boss.
6. A camper's cabin responsibilities are separate from his/her lodge duties. Each camper will have responsibilities for cleaning the cabin they used during the weekend, policing its immediately surrounding environs, and helping to clean the latrine/shower building on their Hill.
7. Tar Hollow is an Ohio State Park and State Park rules therefore apply to all attendees. No pets in the cabins or lodge. No alcohol, weapons or fireworks allowed in the Park, PLEASE!

Please mark your calendars for next year's Tar Hollow weekend. It will be May 18-20, 2012, the weekend before Memorial Day. We just know the weather will be sunny and warm.
